Title Requirements

As of January 1, 2024, title applications for model years 1998 and older will no longer be processed by the Bureau. Title applications along with supporting documentation will be returned and fees rebated.

A list of dates when model year vehicles will become exempt from title:

****As of January 1, 2025, to register a vehicle as an antique vehicle the vehicle must be an automobile or truck manufactured in or after model year 1916 that is **more than 35-year-old; equipped with an engine manufactured either at the same time as the vehicle or to the specifications of the original engine; substantially maintained in original or restored condition.** Used in exhibitions, club activities, parades, or other functions of the public interest.

AN ANTIQUE AUTO CAN NOT BE USED AS THE OWNER'S PRIMARY MODE OF TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS OR GOODS, and may not be a reconstructed vehicle or altered vehicle.

The Antique Affidavit form MV-65 (Rev. 10/2024) would need to be completed and notarized before we can process a registration as an antique auto.****
