- iPhones, iPads, iPod Touch
- Tablets
- Laptops
- Desktop computers

Devices that do not work:

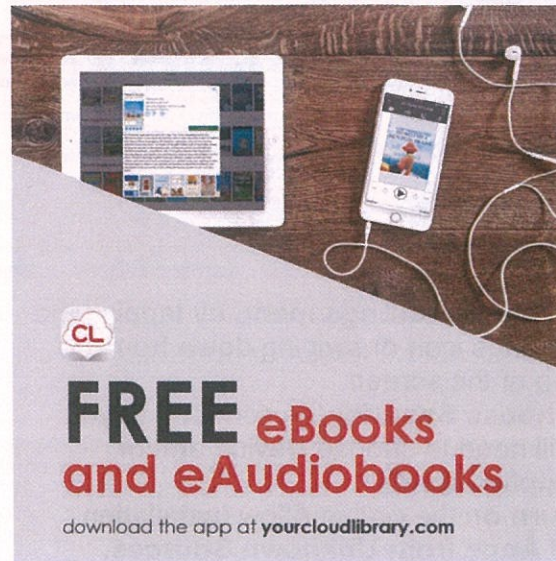
- E-ink Kindles (such as the Kindle e-reader or Paperwhite)
- Mp3 players and iPods that do not support apps

1. Enabling your Fire

Kindle Fire:

Go to the **settings** menu by tapping the settings icon or swiping down from the top of the screen.

Choose Security (on some Fires you will need to choose **Device and/or Applications**).

Turn on the option **Allow Installation of Apps from Unknown Sources**.

You may get a warning message:

Click Ok.

Go back to the **Home** screen.

Repeat these steps at the end of the installation to turn off Apps from Unknown Sources!

Notes

The Kindle app will not update automatically. To update, uninstall and then reinstall using these instructions.

Check your version by tapping on About in the cloudLibrary app menu. Version 3.8.10 was released on June 28th, 2018.

Installing cloudLibrary on your Kindle Fire

2. Download and install the cloudLibrary app

Open the Silk browser and go to <https://www.yourcloudLibrary.com>

Scroll down the page and tap on the **Fire** icon.

Tap on the red **download** button that matches your generation of your Fire. (If you need help determining which Fire you have, use the [online tutorial](#).)

Tap **Ok** to message.

Tap **open** Download complete.

When asked “**Do you want to install this application?**” select **install** and then **open**.

If the app does not open, tap on the **Home** icon and tap on the cloudLibrary icon to open the app.

3. Log in.
